Installation

Wagtail Colour Picker is available on PyPI - to install it, just run:

```
pip install wagtailcolourpicker
```

Once thats done you need to add the following to your ${\tt INSTALLED_APPS}$ settings:

```
INSTALLED_APPS = [
    ...
    'wagtailcolourpicker'
    ...
]
```

Go to your cms admin area and you will see a new icon in the DraftJS toolbar.




Fig. 1: Picker




Fig. 2: Selected Text
